

As per the RFP for One-Stop System services, here are a couple of questions that we have at this point:

1. Due dates are listed as April 26th at 3:30 and 5:00, which do you prefer? (Page 1, 40 and 42)

2. The RFP requires questions be submitted prior to March 26th...I assume this is a typo?

It is a typo – revised RFP was posted immediately after receiving this question. The correct date is April 7, 2010.

3. May we have the forms in Attachment 3 in Word or Excel format so as to make them more easily completed?

Yes. They will be posted on the website along with the revised RFP.

4. May we have the approximate funds by funding stream which makes up the \$2,000,000 as per the RFP?

We do not yet have our allocations for PY2010, so the \$2,000,000 is an estimate. A rough estimate of the breakdown by funding stream would be \$800,000 WTP; \$500,000 WIA DW; \$400,000 WIA Adult; \$300,000 WIA Youth. These are strictly estimates and may vary significantly once allocations are released.

- a. Does this amount include the funds set-aside for participant payments including support services and training expenses?

Yes.

- b. If so, please advise as to the expectation for each funding stream the proportion to be used on support services and training expenses.

We would anticipate that the WIA Adult, Youth and DW would be approximately 20% operating, 80% participant; WTP approximately 60% Operating, 40% participant. These are strictly estimates and dependent upon the service provider.

5. May we have a current count of enrolled cases in WTP, WIA Adult, Youth and DW, TAA and FSET, and the respective status of each?
